

She can be heard on the Anniversary Cast Album of Disenchanted. Thank you to Brian, Bernard, and Debi, and God for trusting me once again, my 3 brilliant daughters, and to Mimi who makes it all possible.

TED SWINDLEY (Author and Original Director) Ted Swindley is internationally

known as writer and director of the popular musical, Always...Patsv Cline. He is the founding artistic director of Stages Rep. in Houston, Texas. He was also named to the Esquire Magazine's register of outstanding Americans in arts and letters. Mr. Swindley was the recipient of the Los Angeles Dramalogue Award for outstanding direction of Carnal Knowledge by Jules Feiffer. Currently, he is president of Ted Swindley Productions, Inc., a theatrical licensing and consulting company, and continues his 30-year career writing plays and musicals, consulting and mentoring playwrights, as well as directing plays for various theatres throughout the U.S. and abroad. Mr. Swindley is an active member of The Dramatists Guild of America and Stage Directors and Choreographers.

PATSY CLINE was born Virginia Patterson Hensley on September 8, 1932. She became one of the most acclaimed vocalists of the 20th century. With roots deep in country music, her sound was the first to successfully cross-over to pop music. In 1957, one of her numerous hits "Walkin' After Midnight" reached Number 2 on the county music chart and Number 16 on the pop music chart. This was the song that she performed on Arthur Godfrey's Talent Scouts show, which eventually led to becoming a regular performer at the Grand Ole Opry. Cline was at the top of her career when she died tragically in a plane crash on March 5, 1963, at the age of 30. Her legacy and popularity remain strong with millions of albums continuing to

sell today. The album, Patsy Cline's Greatest Hits was released in 1967 and broke the world record for the most weeks on the US Charts for any album by a female artist. The album remained on the charts for 722 weeks, taking the Number 1 spot for 251 weeks. In 1973, she posthumously became the first female solo artist to be inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame, and in 2002, she was voted Number 1 on Country Music Television's The 40 Greatest Women of Country Music.

DEBI MARCUCCI (Director) is extraordinarily happy to return home to her WST family and honored to direct Always...Patsy Cline on the Mainstage. Debi has directed productions in the Independence Studio on 3. including Steve Martin's Meteor Shower. Oleanna, Andrew Lloyd Webber's Tell Me on a Sunday, Souvenir, Always...Patsy Cline, Lobby Hero, and the American premieres of Mr. Bailey's Minder and The Ugly One. Elsewhere, she has directed Queen's We Will Rock You, Footloose, Sweet Charity, Flashdance: The Musical, No Way to Treat a Lady, and Lobby Hero. Debi began her climb of the proverbial ladder at WST over 30 years ago and served as Stage Manager of over 120 productions. Now a permanent resident of Florida, Debi is eternally grateful to Bernard Havard for his continued loyalty, support, and love throughout the years. In the words of Patsy Cline "I'm back where I belong, back in baby's arms!"

CHRIS BURCHERI (Music and Vocal Direction) is excited to be concluding his second season as the Walnut's Mainstage music director with Always...Patsy Cline, after previously music directing Young Frankenstein. Shrek, Beehive, and most recently, The Little Mermaid. Based in Philadelphia, he has also music directed at Rutgers-Camden, Arcadia University, and the WST for Kids series, where his musical arrangements have been heard in A Christmas Carol. He is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania. Thank you to Bernard and Mark for this opportunity. Love and thanks to my parents, Maura, and Lauren.

BRIAN FROONJIAN (Scenic Designer) is thrilled to be designing at the Walnut Street Theatre, where he is currently the technical director. He has been designing and creating

He has served on several boards including seven years with the National Alliance for Musical Theatre where he now holds the honorary position of Board Emeritus and the Advisory Committee of Samuel French, the international play publisher and licensing company. With Bernard Havard he co-authored the book Walnut Street Theatre. Since he joined the Walnut in 1994 it has become the most subscribed theatre company in the world.

BERNARD HAVARD (President Producing Artistic Director) Vox Populi (The Voice of the People) was written on the Walnut Playbills in the 1800s. Whenever the Walnut has strayed from a populist program, the theatre has gone bankrupt. When I came here 39 years ago, we had no programs and no audience. Today we enjoy the largest subscription of any theatre in the world. So, my thanks to our loval audience and a warm welcome to newcomers who enjoy and believe in what we do. I have tremendous admiration for the artists who have dedicated their lives to the theatre and the Walnut, in particular, Our theatre is a non-profit 501-C3 institution, and we rely on contributed income to extend our reach into the community. Last season we reached more than 150,000 students in our city schools. We have 20 trustees who give their time, wisdom and contributions to help guide this historical treasure. I came to the Walnut in 1982, and I am as excited now about our future as I was in the beginning. My heartfelt thanks to all who enter this theatre. 
