

THEATRE QUIZ: DISNEY ON BROADWAY

By Andrew Gans

Disney Theatrical Productions, which was formed in 1994, operates under the direction of Thomas Schumacher. Its 10 Broadway titles have been seen by more than 200 million theatregoers worldwide, and those shows have earned 62 Tony nominations, winning Broadway's top honor 20 times. Can you identify some of Disney Theatrical Productions' Broadway outings pictured below? Clues are provided, and answers are upside down at the bottom of the page.

1. Disney Theatrical Productions entered the Broadway arena in 1994 with this Alan Menken-Howard Ashman-Linda Woolverton-Tim Rice musical based on the 1991 animated film of the same name. The Tony-nominated musical played 13 years on Broadway and has been produced in 37 countries worldwide.
2. This Tony-winning Best Musical opened on Broadway in November 1977 at the New Amsterdam and continues its record-breaking run at the Minskoff. The international hit was directed by Julie Taymor, who became the first woman to win the Best Director of a Musical Tony Award.
3. In March 2000, this musical, featuring a score by Elton John and Tim Rice, opened at Broadway's Palace Theatre with a cast led by Heather Headley, Adam Pascal, and Sherie Rene Scott. Directed by Robert Falls, the production won four Tony Awards, including one for Headley's performance in the title role.
4. Everyone's favorite nanny took center stage in this Disney co-production with Cameron Mackintosh, which premiered in London in 2004 before arriving on Broadway in 2006. Based on the stories of P.L. Travers and the 1964 Disney film starring Julie Andrews, the musical was nominated for seven Tony Awards, including Best Musical.
5. This Alan Menken-Howard Ashman-Tim Rice-Chad Beguelin musical, which opened in March 2014 at Broadway's New Amsterdam Theatre, where it continues, is based on the 1992 Disney film of the same name. The musical was nominated for five 2014 Tony Awards, including Best Musical, winning James Monroe Iglehart the award for his performance as the Genie.
6. Based on the 2013 Disney film, which featured the Oscar-winning "Let It Go," this musical, with a score by Kristen Anderson-Lopez and Robert Lopez and a book by Jennifer Lee, opened on Broadway in March 2018, earning Tony nominations for Best Musical, Best Book, and Best Original Score..

RICHARD RODGERS & OSCAR HAMMERSTEIN II (*Music, Lyrics, Original Book*) After long and highly distinguished careers with other collaborators, Richard Rodgers (composer, 1902-79) and Oscar Hammerstein II (librettist/lyricist 1895-1960) joined forces in 1943 to create the most successful partnership in American Musical Theatre. *Oklahoma!* (1943), the first Rodgers & Hammerstein musical, was also the first of a new genre, the musical play, blending Rodgers' sophisticated style of musical comedy (which he had perfected in a 25-year partnership with lyricist Lorenz Hart) with Hammerstein's innovations in operetta (conceived in collaboration with such composers as Jerome Kern). 
